The European Court of Human Rights, with the support of the Human Rights Trust Fund, organises training sessions aimed at magistrates and lawyers within the framework of a Training Unit located on the Court's premises. This programme is implemented in co-operation with the Council of Europe's HELP programme.

These intensive sessions allow participants to discover the Court from the inside, to attend a hearing, to meet with judges and registry members.

The travel and subsistence expenses of the participants are fully borne.

A training session aimed at Moldovan magistrates and lawyers will take place on 1 and 2 October 2013. The session will be held in English; knowledge of this language is obligatory. The draft programme is appended.


